FOLLOW THESE TIPS TO HELP KEEP YOU AND YOUR FAMILY SAFE:

- ✔ Never attempt to repair damaged power lines or remove tree limbs from power lines.
- ✔ If there are power lines nearby, place your ladder at least **1 meter** away from the line. If your ladder is too close, electrical arcing can occur, which could result in serious injury for you if you are on the ladder.
- ✔ Treat all downed lines as if they are energized. Stay at least **10 meters** away (about the length of a bus) and anything they may be touching, including puddles of water and fences.
- ✔ Before starting any big construction projects, call us to let us know. We can help make your work site as safe as possible including checking for underground lines.
